National Domestic Violence TTY Hotline

The National Domestic Violence TTY Hotline (NDVH) is available to Deaf, Hard of Hearing and Deaf-Blind people across the nation. The NDVH headquarters is in Austin, Texas and partners with ADWAS in Seattle. At ADWAS, the national TTY hotline operates 24-hours a day.

The TTY Hotline program offers:

- *Expertise with using TTY etiquette (using GA and SK)
- *Familiarity with Deaf agencies/services across the nation
- *Capable of assisting related to communication and cultural barriers in shelters, hospitals, and other services people may need access.

What reasons do people call the Hotline?

- *Victims are in an immediate crisis situation
- *Families or friends of victims have questions
- *Request for information and referral
- *Need assistance with reducing barrier to services
- *Looking for a safe place to go
- *To have discussions to help develop a plan of action
- *To flee from an abusive home
- *Need assistance for court advocacy
- *Just simply to talk

We have received calls from different states including Texas, California, Tennessee, Washington D.C., New Jersey, Florida, Kentucky, Maryland, Ohio, Virginia and Washington State.
